Diluted Bleach Solution Directions:

For Use as a Mouthwash

or

For Use with an Oral Irrigator

Do not use a bleach product that contains sodium hydroxide (lye). Bleach is called Sodium Hypochlorite.

Needed:

- (1) Gallon container
- (2) Bleach (must be non-concentrated & unscented bleach)
- (3) Water

To Mix Bleach Solution: (Locate the active ingredient area on the bleach bottle label. This will be either 3% or 6% **Sodium Hypochlorite)**

- (1) For 3% Sodium Hypochlorite: Add 4 teaspoons bleach to 1 gallon water
- (2) For 6% Sodium Hypochlorite: Add 2 teaspoons bleach to 1 gallon water

Direction for use as a Mouthwash:

- (1) Swish gently with 1 mouthful of bleach solution for 30 seconds in the morning and evening.
- (2) After rinsing with bleach, rinse gently with clear water.

<u>Directions for use with an Oral Irrigator</u>: (Do <u>not</u> use an oral irrigator until two months after periodontal surgery)

- (1) Obtain oral irrigator. (We recommend the InterPlak Dental Water Jet by Conair)
- (2) Pour 1 cup of the diluted bleach solution into the oral irrigator reservoir.
- (3) Point the stream of water perpendicular to the tooth using the <u>lowest setting</u> on the Oral Irrigator.
- (4) Irrigate until the reservoir of the Oral Irrigator is empty.
- (5) Irrigate with this solution once daily.
- (6) After irrigating with bleach, rinse your mouth with clear water.
- (7) Rinse Oral Irrigator lines & tank afterward with clear water.

WARNING: Bleach solution can damage clothing, carpet, etc. DO NOT SWALLOW BLEACH (Last Updated August 2010)
